

CLOSETS ARE FOR CLOTHES

Cut out, print, or hand-draw letters for the top left as shown. Drawing by hand would allow you to make the letters in perspective. *Please do not add any other title or text to the bulletin board apart from what is provided and described here.*

You may add a border, but please do so with consideration for the intended design. A border around the perspective edges to simulate moulding along a floor might be interesting.

Cut out the various sizes of small doors provided. Mix and match sizes and what goes underneath.

Cut out the statistics, Ways to support a Friend, and the Questions, and put them under the different small doors.

Hang the hangers and clothes inside the closet with the text. Staple the doors at the left edge so they fold open.

The bottom of the bulletin board should be exposed and empty. Use two different-colored sheets of background paper, and cut or fold them under to create a perspective in which the raw bulletin board represents the floor. You could use a third color of background paper if you wanted to do extra work.

Use the large (two-sheet) door taped together to cover two sheets about the bulletin board and National Coming Out Project
