## Delta Gamma History



**Background.** The Delta Gamma Chapter at the University of Florida was formally installed on May 13, 1962 and was composed of 17 charter members.

Presently, the chapter consists of 16 active undergraduate sisters, whose majors range from vocal performance and music education to engineering and nutritional science.

Each sister must earn a required amount of points during the semester, which can be attained by attending weekly meetings, participating in chapter activities, ushering concerts and recitals.

**Community Service.** SAI is continually active in community service. Sisters have performed at a local nursing home as well as at Shands for the arts in medicine program. The chapter has painted the music building practice rooms and participated in the local Adopt-a-Family program. Many sisters have also attended Gator Savors, a CPR-certifying program. We have participated in Habitat for Humanity the WUFT Fund Drive, March for Babies, and Race for the Cure.

**Fundraising.** In the past SAI has held flower and candy sales, a silent auction, car washes, bake sales, and several T-shirt sales. Fundraisers support chapter activities and services and also the SAI Philanthropies.

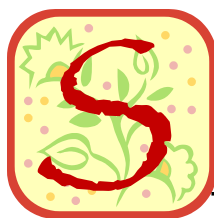
