

Drumline Instrumentation

-UF marches a corps style line: Snare, Tenor, Bass + Cymbals

- * Snares are snares (usually "lead" instrument): notated on single line staff

- * Tenors have four (10', 12', 13', 14') tom-like drums and two "spock" (6') drums - 6 total: the drums are notated in the spaces of the staff with the 2 spocks above

- * Basses have five to six drums. Mr. Birkner likes marching six: these are notated in the spaces of the staff as well. Unisons (all basses) are notated on the center line of the staff.

- * Cymbals are crash cymbals: notated on single line staff

-Usually snares, tenors and cymbals all play single parts while basses play both single and split parts. Split parts in the afore mentioned instruments aren't common, but can be a cool effect.
